



Using the Anishinabek Education System Reporting Racism Tool

What Happens When You Report an Incident of Anti-Indigenous Racism



Incident is reported to the KEB



KEB staff will contact the person who made the report within 24 hours of receiving the report



Confidentiality and consent to share information will be confirmed with the person making the report before taking any next steps.



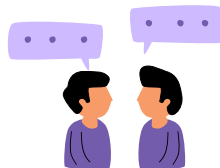
KEB staff will contact the school board, with consents in place, to seek collaborative resolution in response to the report.



KEB staff will consult with the Education Director from the First Nation, with consents in place.



KEB staff will review the reported incident and offer recommendations to the person who made the initial report, with appropriate actions and resolution.



The person who made the initial report will be made aware of the response from the Anishinabek Education System.



The reported incident will be tracked internally to identify where support is needed for addressing anti-Indigenous racism.
