

KINOOMAADZIWIN EDUCATION BODY ANISHINAABEMOWIN TEACHER CONTRACT OPPORTUNITY Summer Course: Level A Anishinaabemowin Teacher (Online)

SUMMARY

The Anishinaabemowin Language Teacher will provide curriculum content in the delivery of a high school credit in July 2024. The course to be offered is LNOA0 – Ojibwe Language, with an emphasis on oral communication. The successful candidate will deliver an online virtual course to meet the needs of Anishinabek students, with one hour of synchronous learning per day.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and deliver engaging, culturally relevant lessons that reflect local perspectives where possible.
- Support students by providing ongoing assessment and evaluation.
- Engage learners through a virtual learning platform D2L.
- Report to the school Principal of the Kinoomaadziwin Education Body Virtual High School

THE REQUIREMENTS

- Valid Ontario College of Teachers' Certificate of Qualification.
- Fluency in Anishinaabemowin preferred.
- Experience using virtual teaching tools and platforms.
- Awareness and appreciation of First Nations culture.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- AQ course in Teaching Ojibwe/Anishinaabemowin is an asset.

HOURS OF WORK

Course offered as an e-Learning course from July 2– July 30, 2024.

LOCATION

This is a remote contract intended to support a virtual course. The successful applicant will work from a remote office to be determined. Reliable internet access is required.

- Resume including detailed work history and education information
- Copy of Ontario College of Teachers (OCT) certificate
- Three professional references (one from current supervisor) with permission to contact

Preference will be given to:

• members of the Participating First Nations or those of Indigenous ancestry,

• candidates who can speak Anishinaabemowin or Lunaape or have a willingness to learn.

The successful candidate will require a valid driver's licence and will be required to submit satisfactory criminal records check and comply with KEB personnel, financial, and other policies.
