In preparation of the upcoming Anishinaabe Giizhigad celebration, the Kinoomaadziwin Education Body (KEB) is pleased to share this Anishinaabemowin and Lunaapeew language resource with all Participating First Nations of the Anishinabek Education System.

As part of our ongoing efforts to support communities in language revitalization, the KEB continues to develop resources and tools that may be used by the Participating First Nations at your convenience.

In the following pages, you will find several activities and word lists that may be used for teachings related to Anishinaabe Giizhigad and throughout National Indigenous History Month. Teachers are welcome to use the resources for in-class lessons or extra-curricular activities.

Students of all ages are encouraged to use the word lists to create their own personal arts and crafts related to Anishinaabe Giizhigad. These can be for themselves, or they can create something for their classmates, friends, and family.

Included in this resource package you will find several activities that may be used at your convenience in the days leading up to the spring season. The resources include:

- 1 list of common words in Anishinaabemowin and Lunaapeew
- 1 colouring page
- 1 Ngo Dwe Waangizid Anishinaabe match game
- 1 Personalized bookmark activity
- 1 colour by numbers page
- 1 set of 6 spring themed memory flash cards in Anishinaabemowin

To encourage the use of oral language, students can say the words they find in the pages out loud, while doing the activities. This may help them to practice speaking Anishinaabemowin.

The activities enclosed in the following pages were developed using the Nbisiing dialect of Anishinaabemowin. They are geared to support students in grades JK to 6, but they can be used and enjoyed by language learners of all ages!

We respect and honour the past, present, and future.












Book It!


