**Summer Course: CPC30 Politics in Action: Making Change**  
**(Online)**

**SUMMARY**

The Teacher will provide curriculum content in the delivery of an Open Canadian and World Studies high school credit to students as part of the Reach Ahead e-learning course being offered in August 2025. The course to be offered is Politics in Action: Making Change (CPC30 – Open). The successful candidate will deliver an online virtual course to meet the needs of Anishinabek students, with one hour of synchronous learning per day. A Field Trip to Ottawa is a component of the course.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Plan and deliver engaging, culturally relevant lessons that reflect local perspectives where possible.
- Support students by providing ongoing assessment and evaluation.
- Engage learners through a virtual learning platform.
- Report to the school Principal of the Kinoomaadziwin Education Body Virtual High School
- Attend field trip to Ottawa August 11-15, 2025

**THE REQUIREMENTS**

- Valid Ontario College of Teachers' Certificate of Qualification.
- Experience using virtual teaching tools and platforms.
- Awareness and appreciation of First Nations culture.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to Provide a VSC Screening

**HOURS OF WORK**

Course offered as an e-Learning course from August 1-29, 2025.

This is a remote contract intended to support a virtual course. Reliable internet access is required.
